



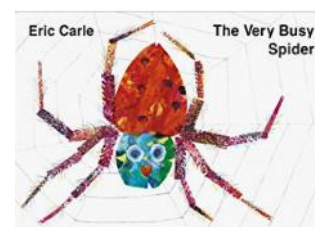
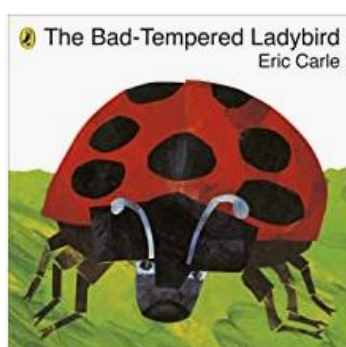
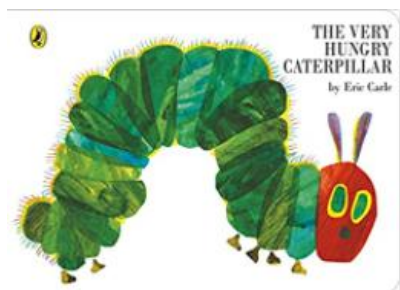
FOUNDATION STAGE TWO NEWSLETTER

Water Bottle & Snack

Children are allowed to bring in water bottles which **can be accessed throughout the session**. Please do not send fizzy drinks and make sure the bottle is labelled clearly with your child's name. During snack time all children will be given the opportunity to have milk and snack (a piece of fruit or vegetable). If you would like your child to have milk please register with COOL MILK.

If you are sending your children with their own snack please make sure it is a healthy snack (no chocolate or sugary snacks please)



Outdoor Clothing

The children will have outdoor learning every day. In warmer weather please send your child with a sun hat and apply sun cream before they come to school. If you send sun cream to school, we will help and supervise your child if they need to apply more.

Helping at Home

- ❖ Read/share a book with your child 3 times a week.

- ❖ Practice counting to and writing numbers to 20 with the correct formation.
- ❖ Practice naming common 3D shapes e.g. cube, cone, and sphere.
- ❖ Talk to your child about the Key Vocabulary on Class Dojo every week.
