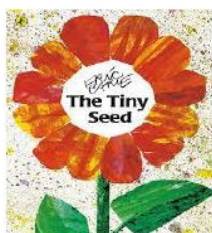
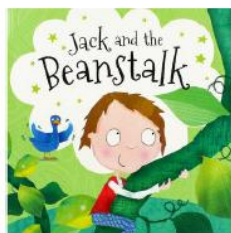
Important dates

Children are asked to bring in a **named** water bottle which can be accessed throughout the session. **No fizzy drinks.**

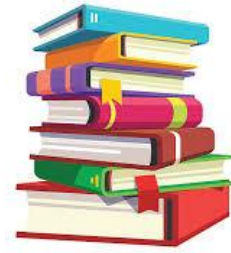
During snack time all children will be given the opportunity to have milk and snack (a piece of fruit or vegetable).

Helping at home



- ❖ Read/share a book with your child 3 times a week.
- ❖ Practice holding a pencil and writing their name.
- ❖ Practice counting to 10 – count the stairs you climb/the plates at tea time.
- ❖ Talk to your child about their day at school.
- ❖ Encourage independent skills, e.g. toileting, putting on and fastening their own coat.
