Welcome back! We hope you have all had a lovely, relaxing break. It is great to see the children back in school all ready to learn. We are all looking forward to another busy half term.

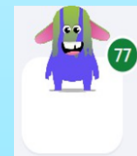
### What are we learning this half term?

<p><b>Composition</b></p> <p>Our text this half term is The Great Fire of London by Emma Adams and The Sea Saw by Tom Percival. We will use the texts as a stimulus for our writing.</p>	<p><b>History</b></p> <p>In History this half term the children will be learning about The Great Fire of London.</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>As mathematicians this half term, the children will be learning about time, mass, capacity and temperature and position and direction</p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>As scientists, our topic 'Coast to Country' will look at the different animal groups, what a herbivore, carnivore and omnivore is and the structure of common animals.</p>
<p><b>Reading</b></p> <p>As readers, we are looking at retrieving information from a text and building our fluency.</p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>Our units in music this half term are Our School and Pattern. These units will be focusing on pulse, rhythm and tempo.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> <p>As sports people, we will be focusing on athletics. They will be mastering basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination. They will then begin to apply these in a range of activities.</p>	<p><b>Art/DT</b></p> <p>In Art, the children will be creating coastal art. In DT, the children will be designing, making and building a model of a 17th century house with doors that open.</p>
<p><b>R.E.</b></p> <p>In RE this half term, our key question is: Are Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur important to Jewish children?</p>	<p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>We will be focusing on the unit changing me.</p>
